Garbage Fun Fact #1

Use the subsidy assistance for home garbage disposal unit and compost bins!

In Fuefuki City, subsidies are issued to purchasers of a home garbage disposal unit, compost bins, to make effective use of resources by reducing the weight and composting of garbage.

Subsidy recipients: Subsidy recipients: Described in the Basic Resident Register of Fuefuki City, one of which is currently a resident in the city, two compost bins, and one garbage disposal unit is limited to one household. (Please contact the Environmental Promotion Division for EM bacteria and organic fertilizer.)

Subsidy amount: Amount within 1/2 of the purchase cost (There is a limit.)

[Subsidy assistance process]

- ① Purchase (Please get a receipt.)
- ② Application (Please bring the receipt, the warranty card (garbage disposal unit), personal seal, and a bank account to receive money.)
- ③ Subsidy assistance can be applied at both the headquarters and each branch

Garbage Fun Fact #2

Disposal of mobile phones and PHS

Rare metals are used for mobile and PHS phones. Please bring unnecessary phones, battery packs, and chargers to your local dealer or mobile phone company.

Garbage Fun Fact #3

Disposal of home PCs

If you want to dispose of a home PC, please dispose of it by the following method.

- (1) If you put it out on the City's Large-sized garbage collection day (it will be collected regardless of a PC recycling symbol or not), the recycling fee is free if it is collected on the Large-sized garbage collection day.
- (2) Personal computers (with the PC recycling symbol) sold after October 2003 will be collected free of charge at the time of disposal because recycling costs are paid by the manufacturer at the time of purchase. If you do not have a PC recycling symbol, a fee will be required for collection. Standard accessories (mouse, keyboard, speaker, cable) at the time of purchase are also collected together.

- Contact the manufacturer about collection by phone or Internet → Send application form to the manufacturer → Pay the collection recycling fee → From the manufacturer, "Eco Yu-Pack Slip" is sent → Pack the PC and paste the slip on. Ask the post office for door-to-door delivery.
